

Dear IRPC Family,

I am very excited for the journey we are going to take. This “all-church” campaign has been birthed out of a lot of prayer, reading, and discussions with many people. I have always enjoyed the times when we have had groups of people processing the morning messages around one consistent theme. The theme for this campaign is “On This Team Everyone Plays.” The take on this campaign is that when we have said yes to Jesus and to IRPC; we have also said yes to being a part of God’s team in IRPC that is committed to working together to fulfill the goal that God has for us. I hope out of this we will all feel like important and necessary members of the team God has designed at IRPC.

You will get the most out of this series when you go through it as a group. There will be several ways for you to connect with a group of people. One option is to get into a formalized small group that meets in someone’s home, another is to connect with a few other people and form your own group, and finally there will be several open groups meeting at the church that you can join.

There are three components to each week’s lesson:

- ∞ First is the Sunday morning message. If you are unable to be here on Sunday morning or want to review the message, they will be uploaded to the website right after the Sunday services.
- ∞ Second will be the group experience. In the group experience you will watch a video to give you a little bit more of an orientation to the topic for the week. There will then be some follow up questions related to the particular topic. Please take advantage of that group time and answer the questions as openly and honestly as possible. Please let what is shared in the group stay within the group. If you miss one of the videos, those will also be made available on our website.
- ∞ Third will be a few things for you do as follow up to the lesson and the small group experience. These are listed at the end of each small group lesson. Some of the activities that you will do will actually be in preparation for the following weeks small group. We really tried not to overwhelm you with activities; rather we wanted you to engage in one or two important things during the week.

At the end of the book is the “Game Plan” page. This is a page for you to write down your insights for the week as well as any possible action steps that you want to take as a result of your discovery for the week.

This is an 8 week campaign, with the hope that during the 9th week your group will go to dinner or do something together to celebrate your time and also to review and commit to your “Game Plan” actions.
